

- ✓ Students can enroll only in ONE course
- ✓ Students cannot be registered in the same course in the same term (summer) with another school
- ✓ Prerequisite course must be completed before the start of the summer session
- ✓ Students transitioning from Grade 9 to Grade 10 can take Culinary Arts 10 Or Art Studio 10
- Students are expected to work independently, stay disciplined, and complete assigned coursework consistently. This includes logging in daily and being prepared to submit work each day. Please note that extended inactivity cannot be accommodated, regardless of the reason—including work, vacations, sports, or family commitments.
- Note: The student and their family must reside within the Mission School District.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What hours will I attend Mission Online Summer School?

At Mission Online Summer School, you have flexibility about when you engage with your online course. You can work at any time—including evenings and weekends—and from any location that fits your schedule. As long as you stay on track and complete the course by the end of the summer session

2. How much time am I expected to spend working on the summer school course each day?

This will vary depending on your work habits and the course, but in general, you should expect to spend around 4–5 hours per day, five days a week—about 20–25 hours per week in order to complete the course on time.

3. What if I do not complete the course by the end of the summer session? Will I be given an extension? Due to the short duration of the summer session, extensions are not available. Final grades will be based on the work completed by the end of the course.

4. I am currently a full-time or cross-enrolled student at Mission Online. Do I need to fill out new paperwork to enroll in a summer course?

If you're already a Mission Online student, there's no need to complete a new registration form for summer session courses. Simply email **missiononline@mpsd.ca** with your full name and the course you'd like to take.

5. I am currently not enrolled, or I am new to Mission Online School. How do I enroll myself?

If you're not currently enrolled in a course or have never taken a course with Mission Online, please complete a Summer School registration form. Forms are available on our school website or in Portable 7 at MSS.

6. When will I get the report card and when my credits will appear on my transcript?

Although you will receive a final grade email from your teacher, official report cards will be issued after the summer break. Transcripts will be updated in September.
