- Friday, Apr. 11–Term 3 ends. Last day for dual enrolled students to sign up for elective courses.
- Tues Apr 15 10 am-11 am Student Immunizations
- Friday, Apr. 18—Good Friday, schools closed
- Monday, April 21—Easter Monday, schools closed
- Monday April 28—Term 3 Learning Updates (report cards)
- Friday, May 16—Noninstructional day, schools closed
- Friday, Jun. 13—Term 4 ends, 3pm Last day to hand in work for final grades.
- Thursday, Jun. 25— Last day to hand in course work, online courses close
- Friday, Jun. 27–Administration day–Final Learning Summaries published


